CAMPGROUND DETAILS

- We will be camping at Scout Camp Otter Lake, Quebec

Friday-Sunday option

- *Friday Drop off:* After 6:00 pm. Youth staying overnight on Friday should have dinner <u>BEFORE</u> coming. (We will have a snack on Friday evening, but not dinner)
- *Pick up*: **10:00 10:30 Sunday**
- *Cost:* \$55
 - o multiple children \$45 for 2nd/3rd child
 - Parent (if staying overnight) cost: \$45
- NOTE: If youth arrives Saturday morning and stays overnight Saturday, cost remains at \$55

Saturday Day-Only Info

- *Drop off:* For 9:00 am. Youth coming for the day should have breakfast BEFORE arriving
- *Pick up*: 20:00 Saturday (or earlier)
- *Cost:* \$30
 - o 2nd/3rd child \$25
 - Parent Cost \$25

Payment & Registration

- Payment required by WEDNESDAY MAY 21 (e-transfer to <u>72ndpaymenst@gmail.com</u> or cash at one of our meetings). Please specify 'Spring Camp' with your child's name in the e-transfer message.
- Registration closes MAY 21
- There are no refunds after the May 21 registration deadline

- No need to send an email to register if paying via e-transfer. If paying via cash, please email Scouter Henry to indicate cash has been paid for registration.
- Additionally, if a parent is camping we will assume you are bringing your own tent unless you indicate otherwise to Scouter Henry.
- If a youth (or adult) is bringing their own food, please email Scouter Henry (<u>henry.starzynski@sympatico.ca</u>) for an adjusted camp cost
- If a parent is staying overnight or coming for the day on Saturday, you need the Scouts Canada 'parent helper' or 'parent overnight' designation. This involves signing the adult code of conduct and watching a short video. You can check if you have one of these designations in your Myscouts profile. If you do not have one of these designations, email Scouter Henry (henry.starzynski@sympatico.ca) and we will get you the details. This MUST BE DONE BY MAY 21.



Food:

- Please let Scouter Henry (henry.starzynski@sympatico.ca) know in advance if your child has any food restrictions we should be aware of (Note all food is Nut-free)
- Youth should not bring any food along unless it has been discussed with Scouter Henry, or your child's section Scouter.

The fine details

- 2-3 youth / tent (due to the amount of equipment and campground space we have)
 - $\circ\quad \mbox{if youth have preferred tent-mates, we can do that}$
- If any parent wants to stay the night with us, please indicate this in the registration
- Cost for parent staying: Weekend: \$45 Saturday Day-only \$25.
- This camp is 'rustic' no running water, no electricity, outhouses.
- If you have one of those 20 litre water jugs and are willing to send it along (with water in it) please let Scouter Henry know. The more water we have, the less we have to run into Otter Lake town to refill

What should your Beaver/Cub bring?
